

# ELIGIBILITY TO VOTE IN THE FIRST NATION SCHOOL BOARD REFERENDUM

- Eligibility to vote:
  - Canadian citizens; and
  - At least 18 years of age;  
and
  - Yukon residents; and
  - Either:
    - Residing in the school attendance area for at least three months; or
    - A parent of a child in attendance at the school.

**Note:** in the case of electors residing in an area with overlapping attendance areas, they may vote in all referendums in which they reside. If an elector has children attending more than one school, they may vote in referendums for each of the schools they have a child in attendance.
