What it's all about

- Returning Officers are responsible for the preparation and delivery of fair, compliant and impartial elections in their electoral districts.

When

- Appointments are long term
- Between elections, there are task assignments and periodic training sessions; these are part-time and flexible. Hours vary.
- During the election period (minimum of 31 days), on-site daily availability is required.
- The election date will be no later than November 2025.

Eligibility

- Must be at least 18 years of age, a Canadian citizen, and a resident in the electoral district.

Qualifications & skills

- Management experience, service-oriented, well-organized, good attention to detail, planning competency, strong communications skills and computer proficiency.
- Non-partisanship as a representative of Elections Yukon.
- Previous election experience not required.

Pay

- Election period pay is \$6,000, with additional pay for milestone activities.
- The yearly honorarium is \$720.
- Readiness tasks are done in 4-8 hour blocks at least twice per year, at your own time at \$30.70 per hour.
